



Facts About the Grant in Memory of Tom Reilly

Eligibility

- A high school senior or graduate, less than 20 years old, who has lost a parent.
- A minimum GPA of 2.5.
- A United States citizen.
- Award consideration will first and foremost be given to a resident of the Greater Philadelphia Metropolitan area.
- Acceptance to an accredited post-secondary institution (vocational/trade school, community college, college, university) as a full-time enrollee in a skilled trades training program leading to certification or degree OR accepted as a full-time student at an accredited college/university pursuing a degree in music.
- Prior BHSM recipients are not eligible nor is any family member of any officer or director of Brave Hearts for Strong Minds.
- Grant is a one-time award and is not renewable.
- As part of the Brave Hearts for Strong Minds philosophy, grant winners are required to “pay it forward” by participating in at least one Brave Hearts for Strong Minds event during the year the grant is awarded. Recipients may complete this requirement on their own or join with BHSM to fulfill this requirement.

Application Requirements

- Completed application form
- Official high school transcripts with a minimum GPA of 2.5
- Acceptance letter from the academic institution the student will be attending
- An essay
- Two letters of recommendation

Important Dates

Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis.

Type of Award

- Grant will range from \$500 - \$2500.
- Grant funds are disbursed directly to the student’s school/college/university account.
